
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


Step 1
Pull the rubber bolt cover back

Step 2
Remove the bolt and rear seat cover






Step 3
Remove the two seat bolts and take the seat off



Step 4
This is the connection for the rear light cluster




Step 5
Using your thumbnail press and pull the connector apart. Do not pull the cables. If you press the correct place the connector comes apart easily



Step 6

Remove the four bolts that holds the existing tail tidy then gently pull the plastic cover downward. This cover just pops off on the three rubber grommets that secure it




Step 7
Using both hands gently pull the cover away from the final two fixings



Step 8
Push the grommet out from the inside of the plastic panel before trying to pull the cables through



Step 9
Once free, feed the cables out of the panel




Step 10
Split Triumph tail light assembly, remove indicators, number plate light and wiring loom to use on your new tail light tidy



Step 11
Fit the number plate light



Step 12
Use the two screws and washers provided



Step 13
Do not over tighten!!




Step 14
Feed the indicators through the hanger as shown



Step 15
Push the indicator flush to the plate



Step 16
Bolt the indicator to the plate using the bolt, fibre washer and nut provided as shown




Step 17
Tighten into position




Step 18
Feed the cable s through the plate once all lights are fixed



Step 19
Push the cables back through the grommet



Step 20
Get all three cables through as shown



Step 21
Feed the cables back through the under-seat cover




Step 22
Press the rubber grommet into place



Step 23
Thread the wiring loom extension through the frame



Step 24
Connect the cables back together, note that the red marker denotes the R/H indicator. Check everything works at this point.



Step 25

Whilst feeding the cables through the seat area push back the plastic under tray and tail tidy into position. This fits easily if you have lined the lugs and grommets up.




Step 26 Push all three lugs into place until the tray is seated properly



Step 27
Fix the new tail tidy in place using the new bolts and fibre washers provided

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
Step 28
Tighten all four bolts, make sure that the cables are not trapped and are sat in the free space



Step 29
Thread the cable under the pipe as shown



Step 30
Store the excess cable in the space shown



Step 31
Reconnect the connector and clip back into place as shown



Step 32
Finally re-fit the seat and rear seat cover
